Summary

The purpose of this After-LIFE Report is to define how the results and achievements of the LIFE PanPuffinus! project will be maintained and further developed beyond the end of the LIFE funding period. In line with the requirements of the LIFE Programme, the report outlines a set of objectives, and corresponding site specific actions required to ensure the sustainability of project outcomes including the continuation of key conservation measures, the long-term use and updating of project outputs, and the ongoing dissemination and uptake of results. It identifies the roles and responsibilities of relevant stakeholders and highlights opportunities for further integration into policy, management and practice.

By setting out a clear framework for the post-project phase, this report aims to ensure that the benefits generated by LIFE PanPuffinus! project are sustained over time and continue to contribute to the conservation of Mediterranean seabirds.
